LEADERSHIP CAMPS

Leadership Camps are opportunities for administrators and teachers to participate in two days of facilitated conversation around continuous improvement using practical wisdom about evaluation processes and special education. Current Leadership Camps are scheduling for evaluation (1.2) and special education (1.3). (Lunch is included both days.) These courses are currently offered for free due to grant funding. **

Leadership Coaching provides individual support for administrators who are former UNI students or have attended a Leadership Camp.
