**Position Title:** Graduate Athletic Training Assistant

**Reports to:** Athletic Training graduate program director and direct supervision of service, depending on setting and location.

**Terms of Employment:**

- For the fall semester: 20 (or 10 if half award) hours per week, beginning August 24, 2020 and ending December 18, 2020. Does not include the week of Thanksgiving Break.
- For the spring semester: 20 (or 10 if half award) hours per week, beginning January 11, 2021 and ending May 7, 2021. Does not include the week of Spring Break.

**Compensation:**

- Full assistantship salary is \$5,395 per semester. Half assistantships may be awarded.
- Salary will be prorated weekly for late start.
- Graduate Assistants may qualify for in-state tuition and fees.
- Graduate Assistants receive University holidays and do not work during Thanksgiving Break, Spring Break, or the interims between semesters.

**Position Description:**

- Potential athletic training positions consist of on campus opportunities with NCAA Division I athletic teams and local secondary schools.
- Specific duties fall within the scope of athletic training practice and vary depending on the specific assignment.
- Preceptor duties within UNI's Athletic Training Program may also exist for certain positions.

**Qualifications:**

- Must be BOC certified and eligible for Iowa athletic training license prior to the start date.
- Must be accepted into the graduate Athletic Training Program.
- Must be enrolled in 9 qualifying graduate-level credit hours each semester of the assistantship
- Maintain a UNI cumulative graduate GPA of at least 3.00. A newly admitted graduate student must have at least a 3.0 GPA for undergraduate or previous graduate work of at least 8 graded credit hours.
